Day: 6 Wise Men

Read Ephesians 21-25

1. What does it say to you when you see that authority in the Bible is always delegated authority?

2. Who will always remain the role model for living out authority in a marriage?

- Matthew 20: 25-28
- John 13: 14-17

3. Evaluate the following models, decide which one is functioning in your marriage at the moment and decide whether it is a Biblical model?

i. Authoritarian Power Ephesians 5: 21-32. (Maybe a wrong interpretations?)

- The husband makes all the important decisions
- Very little emotion or feelings are communicated
- A very strong emphasis on role models - husband and wife
- The husband does not work on the marriage in a constructive way
- The authority very often abused by the husband
- Authority motivated by Ephesians 5: 21-32

ii. The partner and companion model

- Decisions are made by compromises that lead to constant negotiations
- The husband does communicate on an emotional level
- The husband and wife share all interests and obligations in the marriage
- The wife shares the responsibility of earning an income
- They are open to enrichment
- A model very often promoted by the media

iii. The servant and server model

- Decision are taken on the basis of consensus
- The husband tries to understand his wife, emphasis on her thoughts, feelings and needs
- Personal growth is more important than rolls or tasks
- The husband wants to develop his wife's full potential - he receives more
- This model asks for self-denial to the point of death - to the example of Christ
