


Bible Study It's All About God

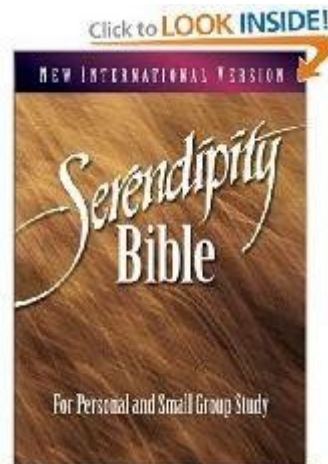
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Day: 7 God's Holiness
