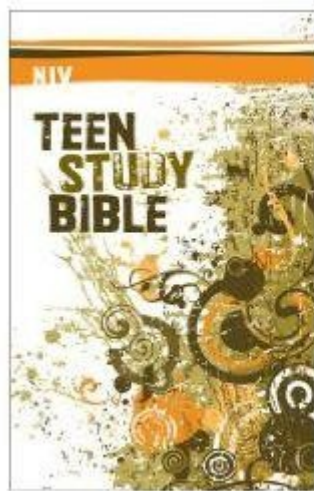


## Bible Study My Life As A Christian

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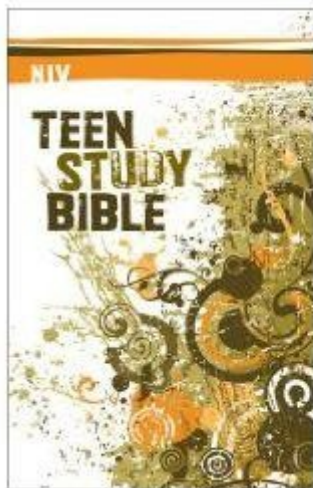
### **Day: 10 Joy In The Church**
