

## **Bible Study, Symbols Of The Holy Spirit, Week 3**

### **Bible Studies**

#### **Day: 1**

*Psalm 78: 1-20 and 1 Corinthians 10: 1-4*

Before you start the new week, think about what last weeks Bible Readings meant to you personally. Pray for the strength to act on it.

1. This week the symbol is water. But we start with the rock of Psalm 78: 20.
2. As in the desert we have rocks all around us all day.
3. Do we see these rocks as stumbling blocks or opportunities?
4. Do you think that if we follow Gods instructions we will see the opportunities?
5. If we follow God, do you think we will see “creeks cascaded from the rock?”

### **Bible Studies**

#### **Day: 2**

*Read: Exodus 40: 1-33, Ephesians 5: 25-27, John 13: 6-10 (text for the day Exodus 40: 12)*

**Exodus 40:12** “Finally, bring Aaron and his sons to the entrance of the Tent of Meeting and wash them with water.”

1. What is the Symbol of the water in Exodus 40: 12?
2. When do you think we were washed clean by the blood of Jesus through the Holy Spirit?
3. So, what is the symbol of the washing of Aaron and his sons?
4. Read John 13: 10. Do you think the “dirty” places needs to be washed again sometimes?

### **Bible Studies**

#### **Day: 3**

*Read Genesis 21: 14-19 (Text verse 19)*

1. How do you make use of God’s blessings?
2. Do you see the “bag” with water or do you see the fountain?
3. The ‘bag’ will run empty; do you think we can limit God’s blessings that way?
4. Are you happy with a ‘bag’ full of church activities and highs of the past?

5. Are drinking from God's fountain all the time or are you satisfied with the "bag" full of blessings?

## **Bible Studies**

### **Day: 4**

*Read Deuteronomy 11: 1-15 (Text Verse 11)*

1. Are you still living in Egypt?
2. Are you still living in doubt and unbelief?
3. Have you crossed the Jordan yet?
4. Are you being cared for by God with rain from heaven, The Holy Spirit?

## **Bible Studies**

### **Day: 5**

*Read Joshua 15: 1-20 and Deuteronomy 11: 12-14 (Text Verse 12)*

1. Do you always realize that our Father gives us more than we need just as Caleb gave to his daughter?
2. Read His promise in John 10: 10 again.
3. He cares for us all year long. Do we always make sure we believe this and live that way?
4. Do we really trust that God will give us all we need?
5. Do you think God gives us what we need at the right moment?
6. Is your time line the same as God's?

## **Bible Studies**

### **Day: 6**

*Read 2 Kings 3: 9-20 (Text Verse 16-17)*

1. Can you see the challenge in these verses?
2. Can we fill the dry valleys in our life with prayer?
3. If we pray, will God fill up these "valleys" in our life with His living water?
4. Are we always aware that God will give us His "overflowing" blessings if we pray to Him in our need?

## **Bible Studies**

**Day: 7**

*Read John 7: 37-39 and John 4: 7-15 (Text John 7: 37)*

1. Do you think that because we were created in God's image we will always have a natural "thirst" for true communion with God?
2. Can it be we suppress it because of an unwillingness to be dependent on any thing?
3. Will we receive the streams of living "water" if we admit it and "drink" from the overflowing plenty we can receive from Jesus?
4. Are you ready to do it?
